Job Title: Warehouse Operative / Workshop Assistant

Position: Full time (37.5 hours per week) mix of warehouse and production work

Job Specification

We are seeking staff to work as part of the manufacturing and dispatch operation in the N17 warehouse.

This role is split between two departments, and the successful candidate will work defined hours in each department.

The warehouse part of the job will principally involve taking in deliveries, handling stock and packing orders. The work is physically demanding. Although we have manual handling equipment it often involves heavy lifting.

The wood machining part of the job involves assisting the Production Manager on designated days in machining fabricated products, mainly artists' stretcher bars and frames. The successful candidate will be trained to use spindle molders, tenoners, cross-cutters, under-pinners, mitre saws and routers,
